ESL Assessment for Prospective Students

The TOEFL is not required for admission to Parkland College. However, to determine English-language ability:

- Prospective students who have taken the TOEFL and scored 61 (online) or 500 (print) or higher need only to complete a writing sample.
- Prospective students who have not taken the TOEFL will take an English language assessment upon arriving at Parkland.
