

Parkland-ICTM Math Contest

SUPPLEMENTARY RULES

1. Attending Parkland's regional contest allows for the opportunity to bring *more* students than is allowed by ICTM. A school may enter any number of its students in any of the written competitions at Parkland; however, only those students predesignated as ICTM will be eligible for ICTM awards and advancement to the state finals. The non-ICTM registered students will be referred to as "Parkland" registered students.
2. A school may enter two additional teams in each group competition (except orals) above the number allowed by ICTM. These additional teams will be referred to as "Parkland" teams. The Orals Competition is strictly an ICTM event.
3. The school registration fee paid to ICTM will include all the students from that school who wish to participate as ICTM-registered contestants. **However, Parkland will charge an additional \$4 for each "Parkland" registered student.**
4. ICTM does not allow 7th or 8th grade students to participate. Parkland does! We encourage their participation. They should realize that they are competing locally only and cannot advance to the state finals. This is great experience for later competition. All 7th and 8th graders must be "Parkland" registered for all of their events.
5. We reserve the right to pre-determine the times at which oral participants will compete.
6. The ICTM awards as provided will be given. However, Parkland will supplement the written competition award with medallions (top 15 percent). Any Parkland-registered individual or team winning an award will be given a Parkland medallion or ribbon in lieu of an ICTM award.
