2-B-2 details and explanations:

1. The following requirements are met by transferable courses in the AAS degree: ANI 300, ART 102, ART 105, ART 106, ART 329, COM 220, ENG 103 and 104, GAM 224, GPH 213, GPH 250, GPH 338, IT 130.
2. Parkland students who complete the requirements indicated in this 2-B-2 agreement would have the following requirements waived in the DePaul CTI Graphics and Animation degree program, HCI 315.
3. Parkland students would have no major electives required in their program at CTI.
4. The Bridge courses are listed in addition to the AAS degree. Parkland students should take 4 more GE courses. However, if students wish to take the additional GE courses after they transfer to DePaul, they may do so, understanding that it will take more than 2 years to finish the degree program.
5. General Education Courses should be IAI approved courses that correspond to this distribution of the Liberal Studies requirements at DePaul:

Writing (Met @ Parkland, see #1 above)	ENG 103 and ENG 104
Mathematical & Technological Reasoning	Not Required
Sophomore Year	Multiculturalism in the US ISP 200
Jr Yr Experiential Learning	Required

Learning Domains

Arts and literature (AL)	3 courses required, one must be GPH 211 (not more than 2 courses from the same department/program)
Philosophical Inquiry (PI)	2 courses required
Religious Dimensions (RD)	1 Religious and Ethical Questions 1 Religious Traditions
Scientific Inquiry (SI)	One SI Lab or SI Quantitative-Lab required
Self, Society, & The Modern World (MW)	3 courses required. CSC 223, IS 208 or IT 201 recommended
Understanding the Past (UP)	2 Courses Required (each from a different category)
Two additional Liberal Studies courses, each from different learning domains.	
1 of the PI or RD courses must be an ethics course; CSC 208 strongly recommended; PHL/REL/MGT 228 recommended
