Student Loan Request

Federal Student Aid regulations provide the potential for Independent and Dependent students to borrow additional money in Federal Unsubsidized Direct Loans. The maximum amount of eligibility is determined by the student’s remaining unmet need, which is calculated as Cost of Attendance (COA) minus all other aid.

In order to receive an additional unsubsidized loan, students are required to complete:

1. Unsubsidized Student Loan Request
2. Monthly Budget Worksheet
3. Written explanation as to the reason(s) for needing additional loan monies.

This form and all required documentation must be submitted in person to a Financial Aid Advisor during their walk-in schedule: Monday through Friday 9:00 – 11:30 and 1:30 – 4:00.
