

Dropbox - Annotate learner submissions

Dropbox now has a built-in annotation toolbar to provide contextual feedback with highlighting, free hand drawing, shapes and associated commenting. This allows instructors to complete evaluation and feedback directly on the submission. NOTE: this is not yet turned on for the campus. 

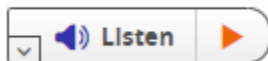
