The starting salary for a Round Lake Park Police Officer is \$64,046.53

Eligibility Requirements:

- \$25 non-refundable application fee;
 - U.S. Citizenship;
 - Valid Driver's License;
 - Must be 21 years of age and less than 35 years of age at time of written exam (5.4.19). Applicants who are currently police officers, or have previously been police officers, and are less than 40 years of age, are exempt from the 35-year age limit;
 - Must have a current and valid POWER Test card issued within 12 months **prior** to written exam date (cards considered valid only if issued 5.4.18 – 5.4.19). Candidates taking the POWER test after the application deadline **MUST** bring a photocopy of the valid POWER Test card to sign-in on test day;
 - POWER cards are accepted from all licensed agencies

 - Applicants must have **ONE** of the following:
 - At least 60 semester (90 quarter) hours of credit from a college or university accredited by one of the six regional accrediting bodies responsible for evaluating two and four year institutions that grant associate's or bachelor's degrees (original, official transcripts due at application deadline);
- OR**
- At least 30 semester (45 quarter) hours of credit from a college or university accredited by one of the six regional accrediting bodies responsible for evaluating two and four years institutions that grant associate's or bachelor's degree **AND** one (1) year of continuous active military duty in the armed forces of the United States (original, official transcripts **AND** copy of DD-214 long form due at application deadline);
- OR**
- Four (4) years of continuous active military duty in the armed forces of the United States (copy of DD-214 long form due at application deadline);

OR

- Current service as a police officer certified by the State of Illinois and actively working for not less than two (2) continuous years for a regularly constituted police department of an Illinois municipality (copy of Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board Law Enforcement Officer certificate **AND** letter from current employer due at application deadline).

Orientation and Testing Information:

Candidates must attend the mandatory orientation and written examination on **Saturday, May 4, 2019**. Sign-in begins at 8:00 a.m. **Please arrive no later than 8:30 a.m.** with a photo ID (driver's license, state ID, military ID) to sign-in. **Late arrivals will not be permitted. All electronic communication devices must be left in your vehicle and will not be permitted into the testing area.** Testing will take place in Skokie, IL. The exact testing location will be provided to eligible candidates prior to the exam date.
