Parkland College Student Right-to-Know Act Graduation and Transfer Rates (2018FA Cohort)

As an institution participating in Title IV Higher Education Act programs, Parkland Community College is required by federal law to disclose graduation and transfer rates (transfer to other institutions) in compliance with the Student Right-to-Know Act. Information on program completions and transfer to other institutions by Parkland students is provided by the Illinois Community College Board (ICCB).

In Fall 2018, a cohort of 706 first-time, full-time, degree-seeking undergraduate students entered Parkland College. ICCB tracked this cohort from Fall 2018 through Summer 2021 (3 years). After 3 years, 62.6% of these students were categorized as successful (compared to a 61.9% success rate for all Illinois Community Colleges). Successful students are those who graduated, transferred to another institution, or were still enrolled after 150% time (i.e., 3 years for a 2-year Associate program). Table 1 displays the single-year graduation and transfer rates of Parkland's cohort and all Illinois community colleges. Table 2 shows the 4-year average. Tables 3 and 4 show graduation and transfer rates by athletic aid status, gender, and race/ethnicity. Tables 5 and 6 show the 4-year average graduation and transfer rates by athletic aid status, gender, and race/ethnicity. Table 7 shows the fall-to-fall retention rates for the Fall 2019 cohort.
