TAX FILERS:

- I used the IRS Data Retrieval Tool on the FAFSA.

D. Illinois Residency Verification

The Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) requires independent students to verify Illinois residency.

“RESIDENTS OF ILLINOIS” is defined as: “An independent student who resides in Illinois (at the time of application), and has so resided for a period of twelve continuous months immediately prior to **September 1, 2017**.”

You must submit a copy of **one** of the acceptable documents listed below with a date of issuance between **September 1, 2016 and September 1, 2017**.
