TAX FILERS:

- I used the IRS Data Retrieval Tool on the FAFSA.
- I am attaching an IRS tax return transcript for 2020.
- I am attaching a signed copy of my 2020 1040 and Schedules 1, 2, and 3.

NOTE: If you were recently married and filed separate returns, you will need to submit a copy of both you and your spouse's 2020 tax return transcripts.

NON TAX FILERS:

- I was employed in 2020 and have attached copies of all my (and my spouse's if applicable) 2020 W-2 forms and verification of non-filing letter(s) from the IRS.
- I was not employed (and or my spouse was not employed), had no income earned from work in 2020 and have attached verification of non-filing letter(s) from the IRS.
- I (and/or my spouse) certify that I do not have a Social Security Number, an Individual Taxpayer Identification number (ITIN), or an Employer Identification Number (EIN) and I am unable to obtain a Non-filing Tax Document from the IRS for the 2020 tax year.
- I (and/or my spouse) have attempted to obtain a Non-filing Tax Document from the IRS for the 2020 tax year and am unable to obtain the required documentation.

To obtain a 2020 IRS Non-Filer Statement, either call 1-800-908-9946 or go to <http://www.irs.gov/pub//irs-pdf/f4506t.pdf> and fill out a Form 4506-T Request for Transcript of Tax Return (make sure to check 7 - Verification of Nonfiling) and mail to the address provided on the form.

If you did not file taxes in 2020 please write an explanation below as to how you supported the family in 2020. Please provide any supporting documentation showing there was an attempt to obtain a Non-Filer Statement.

Illinois Residency Verification

The Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) requires independent students to verify Illinois residency.

“RESIDENTS OF ILLINOIS” is defined as: “An independent student who resides in Illinois (at the time of application), and has so resided for a period of twelve continuous months immediately prior to **September 1, 2021**.”

You must submit a copy of one of the acceptable documents listed below with a date of issuance between **September 1, 2020 and September 1, 2021**.
