TAX FILERS:

- □ I used the IRS Data Retrieval Tool on the FAFSA.

If you did not file taxes in 2021 please write an explanation below as to how you supported the family in 2021. Please provide any supporting documentation showing there was an attempt to obtain a Non-Filer Statement.

Illinois Residency Verification

The Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) requires independent students to verify Illinois residency.

For an independent student to be considered a resident of Illinois they must have physically resided in Illinois for 12 continuous full months immediately **prior to the start of the academic year** for which assistance is requested and Illinois must be their true, fixed, and permanent home.

You <u>must</u> submit a copy of <u>one</u> of the acceptable documents listed below with a date of issuance between <u>September 1, 2021 and September 1, 2022.</u>
