This is to acknowledge that Parkland College District No. 505 is in receipt of your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request received on October 15, 2025, for the following records:

"[1] the decision of the United States government to designate the month of October as "*Cybersecurity Awareness Month*";^[1] [2] the February 25th 2025 glowing articles (of CNN and NBC) heaping praise on the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) for their good-faith efforts to have the medical license of Joel Le Scouarnec revoked in Calendar Year 2005 (approximately twenty years ago);^[2] [3] Michael A. Ayele (a.k.a) W correspondence with Michigan State University (MSU) on matters pertaining to cybersecurity at that university."

The college did a thorough search and does not have any records responsive to your request in its possession.
