RE: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Ms. Galvin:

This is to acknowledge that Parkland College District No. 505 is in receipt of your *Freedom of Information Act* (FOIA) request dated September 27, 2019 received in my office at 1:11 p.m. via electronic mail. As the Vice President for Communications and External Affairs, I am responsible for processing requests for public information for the College, pursuant to *the Illinois Freedom of Information Act*, 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq. In your e-mail, you requested that the College make available the following records:

Request:

“I am writing to request data related to course-level dual credit enrollment for the most recently available three fiscal years, preferably in Excel format. Specifically, which high schools or school districts your institution partners with to offer dual credit courses, the cost per course and the responsible party (college, district/school, or student), and the teacher credentials per course.”

Parkland College’s Response:

A document containing the requested information has been attached to this message in an .XLS format. We believe this document to be fully responsive to your request.

As Vice President for Communications and External Affairs, I am responsible for granting and denying the requests for records under the *Freedom of Information Act*. Finally, if you believe that this response constitutes a denial of your request, you have the right to have this response reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a).
