Dear Mr. Evans:

This is to acknowledge that Parkland College District No. 505 is in receipt of your *Freedom of Information Act* (FOIA) request dated July 20, 2018 received in my office at 5:44PM on July 20, 2018 via electronic mail. As the Vice President for Communications and External Affairs, I am responsible for processing requests for public information for the College, pursuant to *the Illinois Freedom of Information Act*, 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq. In your e-mail, you requested that the College make available the following records:

Request #1: "I would like to submit a data request for access to directory information. This includes all students enrolled for the Spring 2018 term at your University (Undergrad and Graduate). The information I would like includes; Name, address, Class Standing, phone number, Major, E-mail. I am requesting this data in excel/csv format if possible."

Parkland College's Response:

Your request is a repeat request for the same record that has been properly denied and, for that reason, is considered unduly burdensome. 5 ILCS 140/(3)(g) states the following:

"Repeated requests from the same person for the same records that are unchanged or identical to records previously provided or properly denied under this Act shall be deemed unduly burdensome under this provision."

The college has documented identical requests for the information above on the following dates and times:

- June 12, 2018 – 7:18 p.m.
- June 26, 2018 – 7:38 p.m.
- July 5, 2018 – 1:56 p.m.

The college responded to each of these requests on the following dates:

- June 14, 2018 – 2:11 p.m.
- June 27, 2018 – 7:52 a.m.
- July 11, 2018 – 12:32 p.m.

As Vice President for Communications and External Affairs, I am responsible for granting and denying the requests for records under the *Freedom of Information Act*. Please be aware that this response to your request is pursuant to my understanding of your FOIA request. If I have misunderstood your request,

please let me know as soon as possible so I may provide the correct information.

Finally, if you believe that this response constitutes a denial of your request, you have the right to have this response reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:
