This letter is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request received on October 13, 2019 at 3:03 p.m. This message was originally directed toward the College's Technology Help Desk and later identified as a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, as indicated in my follow-up email to you on Tuesday, October 15, 2019. As the Vice President for Communications and External Affairs, I am responsible for processing requests for public information for the College, pursuant to *the Illinois Freedom of Information Act*, 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq.

The following is the original request submitted to the College for responsive records:

"I am not sure if this is the right place for this request. I need to have confirmation of any emails I sent to Mr Hastings from Oct 3, 2017 to Oct 12, 2017. There will not be any so really I need something that says you checked the server and no emails were sent during that time period.

Parkland College's Response:
