This is to acknowledge that Parkland College District No. 505 is in receipt of your *Freedom of Information Act* (FOIA) request dated March 2, 2020 at 8:47 a.m. via electronic mail.

As the Vice President for Communications and External Affairs, I am responsible for processing requests for public information for the College, pursuant to *the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq.* In your original request you asked that the College make the following records available:

1. Copies of all job sign in sheets and/or employee verification sheets in which this project and/or any solar projects were discussed
2. Copies of any signed or tentative contract documents between Parkland Community College and any solar projects.
3. Copies of any and all Certified Payroll documents regarding any solar work being performed at Parkland Community College.

Parkland College's Response:

The College has attached three .PDF documents that are responsive to your request.

The College does not have any documents within its possession for certified payroll documents as requested.
