

Dear Myles Spence:

Thank you for writing to Parkland College (the College) with your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq.

On April 28, 2025, you requested the following documents related to your time as a student enrolled in the aviation program between 2019 and 2021:

- 1. Complete Spring 2019 billing statement
- 2. Student Guide in effect on January 14, 2019
- 3. Aircraft Operations Manuals 2019-2021
- 4. Manuver Standardizations
- 5. Additional/clarified information regarding Instructor Kuey, unrelated to an unknown incident

We have enclosed copies of the documents responsive to your request to the extent they were not included in the documents previously provided to you through your prior April 2025 FOIAs. See enclosed Parkland 000735-001116.

With regard to item 1, during the Spring 2019 semester, the College was still using a Dispatch Director server that is now offline. Therefore, the information you are requesting is no longer available in the same format as the later semesters. A Spring 2019 AVI 101 flight detail report is enclosed in addition to the statement summary previously provided to you.

With regard to item 2, the College used the Flight Instructor Guide and Student Guide as separate documents in lieu of the "Academic & Operations Manual" during the 2018-2019 academic year. Those documents are enclosed.

You have a right to have the denial of your request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:

You also have the right to seek judicial review of your denial by filing a lawsuit in the State circuit court. 5 ILCS 140/11.

If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this denial letter. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this denial letter when filing a Request for Review with the PAC.
