This is to acknowledge that Parkland College District No. 505 is in receipt of your commercial Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request received September 13, 2023, for the following records:

- “1) A copy of the last property & casualty insurance renewal summary for all lines of insurance (general liability, auto, workers comp, professional, directors and officers, ect.). This document summarizes the insurance terms, limits, deductibles, premium and exclusions. If no summary exists than we request the declarations pages of each in-force policy of insurance.
- 2) A copy of the last employee benefits insurance renewal summary for health, dental and vision plans sponsored you. This document shows plan options available to the employees and the pricing for employee, employee plus spouse, employee plus family.”

I have attached two documents that we believe to be fully responsive to your request.

As Vice President for Strategic Partnerships and Workforce Innovation, I am responsible for granting and denying the requests for records under the *Freedom of Information Act*. Please be aware that this response to your request is pursuant to my understanding of your FOIA request.
