Dear Mr. Parker:

This is to acknowledge that Parkland College District No. 505 received your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request received February 13, 2025, for records between Parkland College and ETC Eats Treats & Catering Inc. On February 21, the college extended the response period by five business days as allowable by statute.

The college has attached two documents that we believe to be fully responsive to your request. They include:

- The college's current contract with Campus Culinary Solutions, LLC to operate Eats Treats & Catering on the college campus.
- A PDF containing 339 pages of correspondence between the college and Campus Culinary Solutions, ETC, and Alexandria Niizuma.

The college does not charge rent to Campus Culinary Solutions as part of the space rental, so no ledger records exist between the two organizations for this purpose.

As the Freedom of Information Act Officer for the college, I am responsible for granting and denying the requests for records under the Freedom of Information Act. Please be aware that this response to your request is pursuant to my understanding of your FOIA request. If I have misunderstood your request, please let me know as soon as possible so I may provide the correct information.

Finally, if you believe that this response constitutes a denial of your request, you have the right to have this response reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:
