Parkland can help you with the career assessments, training, and supportive resources you'll find within these pages. We'll not only support but also celebrate your success along the way.

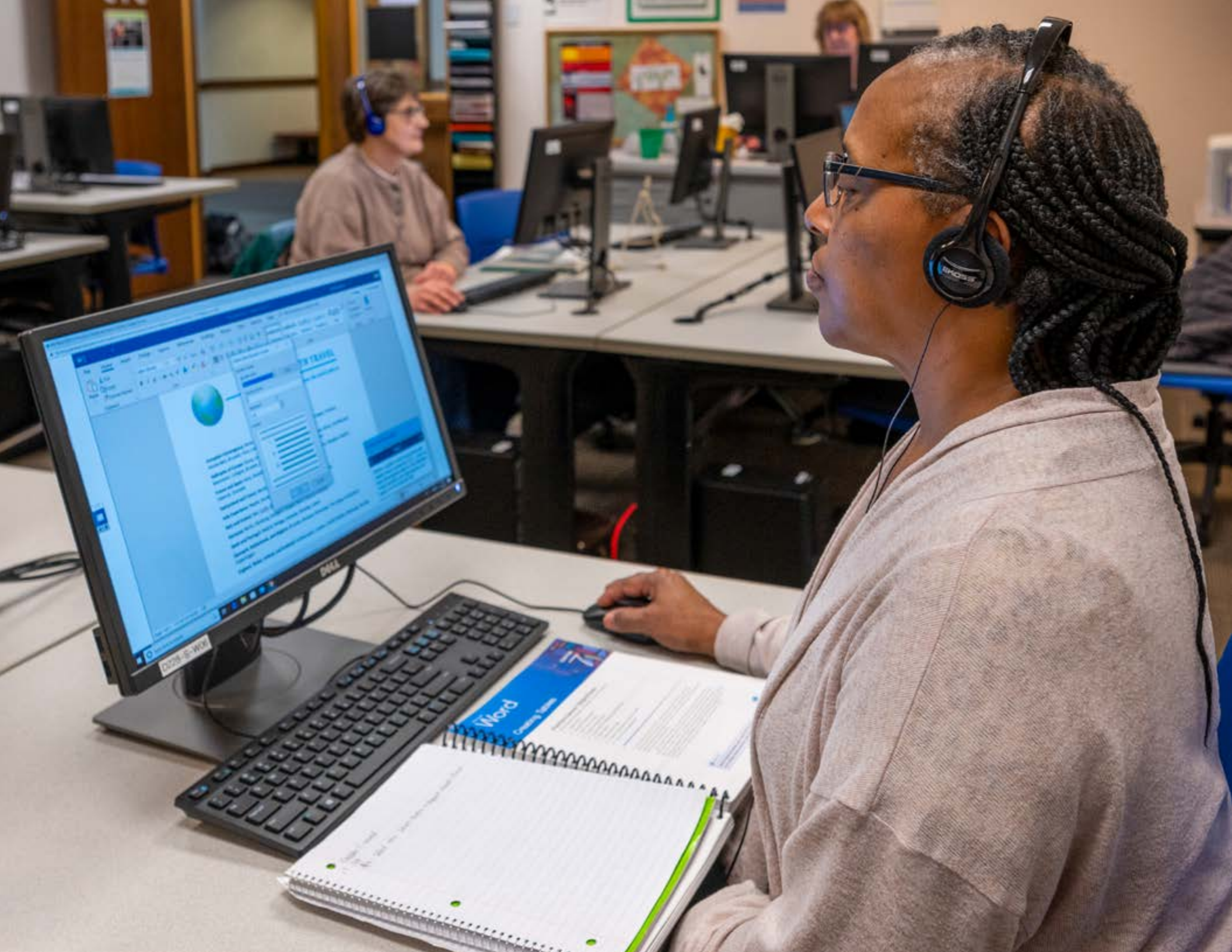

The Flightpath: Convenient College, Short-Term Training

Even if you work during the day, care for kids or aging parents, or serve in the military, you can **complete college**. Many of our students do. That's why Parkland has designed classes and programs that busy adults can fit into their lives. Some take place on the weekends, others after hours. Others let you stay home and complete them from your computer or laptop. It's college, your way. It's your time to soar.

Optional Modes of Instruction at Parkland College*

Many classes are in-person; class sections taught in optional modes have one of the following letters at the end. (E.g., while ENG 102-051W is taught online only, ENG 102-014H is the same class taught in a hybrid format. ENG 098-001 is held only on campus.)

- **ONLINE (W, V):** Classes may be scheduled (V), in which students meet online at a designated time or unscheduled (W) with students working on the materials at a time of their choosing. You'll interact with faculty and classmates through online office hours, chats, discussion posts, and email.
- **HYBRID (H):** You'll be expected to attend some meeting times on campus and complete most of the work online.
- **FLEXIBLE (F):** You choose whether to come to campus, stay home, watch a live stream, or watch the recorded class before the next class session. Faculty may require in-person attendance at certain times.

**You will need a computer or laptop, webcam or headset with microphone, and reliable Wi-Fi. Parkland can help here, too. For more on technology requirements for our classes, visit parkland.edu/VirtualCampus.*

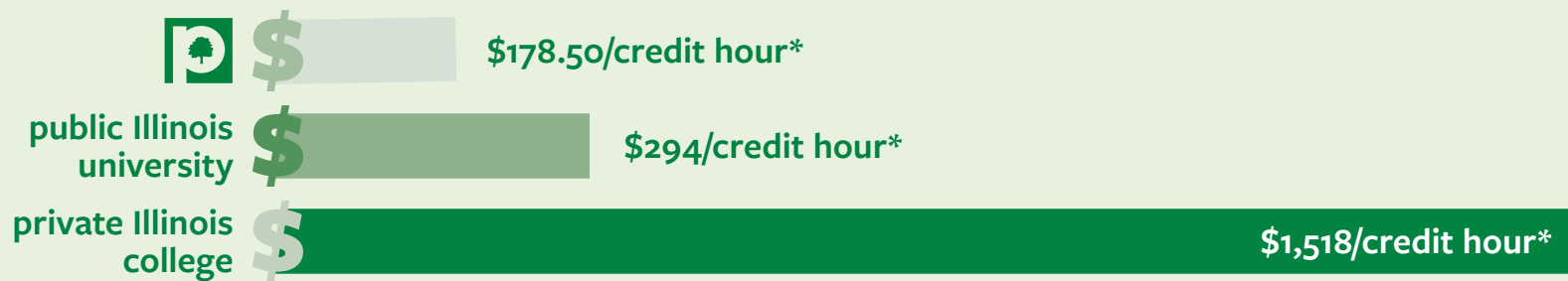

Under this model, a four credit-hour class would cost **\$714** at Parkland, **\$1,176** at a public Illinois university, and **\$6,072** at a private Illinois college.
