- 3. **Call Office of Admissions** to verify transcripts have been received and to see if you need assessment testing at (217) 351-2482 or <u>admissions@parkland.edu</u>
 - 4. Assessment Testing visit <u>Assessment Center</u> for more information on testing.
 - Reading place into college level reading or have earned a "C" or above in CCS 099
 - English must be eligible to enroll in ENG 101
 - Is English your 2nd language? If so, you must take the TOEFL or IELTS & achieve a minimum or greater score of 20-22-26-20 & 6.5-6.5-8-5.5 respectively (must be completed prior to applying)
 - Math place out of MAT 072 within the past 2 years or completion of college level math within the past 5 years Note: developmental math expires in 2 years.
- 5. **Meet with an Academic Success Advisor for pre-Health Professions**: U267, (217) 351-2219, or book an appointment at <u>Appointment Scheduling</u> to review assessment scores and create a plan of study.
 - You must be eligible to enroll in BIO 121 before applying.
 - Science courses used for scoring expire after 5 years (BIO, CHE and PHY)
- Take the <u>Kaplan Nursing Assessment Test</u>. Schedule an appointment by calling (217) 351-2432 or visit <u>Assessment Center</u> Kaplan test scores are good for 2 years. Students can test twice a semester. Students will be scored using the highest Total Score.
