- $\quad$ Schedule study time. Study time will vary with each individual. General estimation is based on a 1:2 to 1:3 ratio of classroom time to study time. That means for every hour that you spend in class, it is recommended that you schedule 3 hours per week for reading, studying and completing assignments. For example:
OTA 111 = a minimum of 6-9 hours per week
OTA 112 = a minimum of 10 to 15 hours per week
- OTA 112 has homework assignments that require approximately 3-4 hours per week of homework in addition to the reading assignments. Audiovisual materials and computer-assisted instruction are required outside of scheduled class time.
- Level I Fieldwork assignments in OTA 112 require the student to plan time to participate in community based activities. Approximately 3 to 4 assignments at 2-3 hours per assignment and a service learning project that requires $\sim 15$ hours total.
