1. Go to www.parkland.edu/lpnbridge, click on **How to Apply** and complete the online orientation "**Get the Facts**"
2. **Apply** as a degree seeking student and be accepted to Parkland College.
 - If you have not applied or attended in the past 12 months, submit a new application.
3. **Transcripts** (all transcripts must be sent from the original institution directly to Parkland at admissions@parkland.edu)
 - High School or GED (if high school transcripts were previously sent prior to graduation, have resent).
 - All college transcripts (other than Parkland) request final fall transcripts be sent in January.
4. **Call Office of Admissions** to verify transcripts have been received & to see if you need assessment testing at (217) 351-2482 or admissions@parkland.edu
5. **Assessment Testing-** by appointment only, call (217) 351-2432 or visit www.parkland.edu/assessment to schedule your tests.
 - **Biology-** You must have completed BIO 121 with a grade of "C" or better within 5 years or less from the time of admission;
 - **Psychology-** You must have completed PSY 101 with a grade of "C" or better;
 - **English-** You must have completed ENG 101 with a grade of "C" or better
 - *Is English your 2nd language?* If so, you must take the TOEFL or IELTS & achieve a minimum or greater scores of 20-22-26-20 & 6.5-6.5-8-5.5 respectively (**must be completed prior to applying**)
 - **Math** – place out of MAT 072 within the past 2 years or completion of college level math within the past 5 years Note: developmental math expires in 2 years
6. **Meet with Health Professions Academic Advisor:** U267, (217) 351-2219, or book an appointment at [Appointment Scheduling](#) to review assessment scores and Science requirements. Create a plan of study.
7. **Take the Kaplan Nursing Assessment Test.** Schedule an appointment by calling (217) 351-2432 or visit www.parkland.edu/assessment Kaplan test scores are good for 2 years. Students can test twice a semester. Students will be scored using the highest Total Score.
8. **Make sure your address is correct** for college records. Moved recently? Complete Change of Address form and return to the Office of Admissions in U214.
