Complete each step below:

- Go to www.parkland.edu/nur, click on **How to Apply** and complete the online orientation "Get the Facts" and the associated survey.
- Apply** and be accepted to Parkland College. If you applied previously, you may need to update your application.
- Transcripts** (all transcripts must be sent from the original institution directly to Parkland)
 - High School or GED (if high school transcripts were previously sent prior to graduation, have re-sent).
 - All** College transcripts (other than Parkland). Request final Fall transcripts be sent in January.
 - SAT or ACT scores (if less than 24 months after your high school graduation date).
- Call Parkland Admissions** to verify **transcripts** have been received and to see if you need **assessment testing**: (217) 351-2482, admissions@parkland.edu

Assessment Testing – call (217) 351-2432 to schedule your tests or visit: www.parkland.edu/assessment

- Reading** – place into college level reading or have earned a "C" or above in CCS 099
- English** – must be eligible to enroll in ENG 101
 - Is English your 2nd language? If so, you must take the TOEFL or IELTS & achieve a minimum or greater score of 20-22-26-20 & 6.5-6.5-8-5.5 respectively (**must be completed prior to applying**)
- Math** – place out of MAT 072 within the past 2 ½ years or completion of college level math within the past 5 years Note: developmental math expires in 2 years.
- Meet with Counseling and Advising**: U267, (217) 351-2219, counselingservices@parkland.edu
 - Review assessment scores and science requirements; **you must be eligible to enroll in BIO 121** before applying. Create a plan of study. Required Science courses expire after 5 years of completion.
- Take the [Kaplan Nursing Assessment Test](#). Call 217/351-2432 or stop by the Parkland Assessment Center for more information or to make an appointment. You may take the test twice.
- Make sure your address is correct for college records. Moved recently? Complete Change of Address form and return to Admissions U-214.
- Submit this form and \$10 application fee
 - Email the completed form to admissions@parkland.edu. Admissions will contact you regarding payment.
