## Complete each step below:

1. Go to [www.parkland.edu/paramedicbridge](http://www.parkland.edu/paramedicbridge) click on **How to Apply** and complete the online orientation "Get the Facts" and the associated survey.
2. **Apply** and be accepted to Parkland College. If you applied previously, you may need to update your application.
3. **Transcripts** (all transcripts must be sent from the original institution directly to Parkland)
  - High School or GED (if high school transcripts were previously sent prior to graduation, have re-sent).
  - **All** College transcripts (other than Parkland). Request final Fall transcripts be sent in January.
  - SAT and ACT scores (if less than 24 months after your high school graduation date).
4. **Call Parkland Admissions** to verify transcripts have been received and to see if you need assessment testing: (217) 351-2482, [admissions@parkland.edu](mailto:admissions@parkland.edu)
5. **Assessment Testing**- call (217) 351-2432 to schedule your tests or visit <http://www.parkland.edu/assessment>.
6. **Math**-place out of MAT 072 within the past 2 ½ years or completion of college level math within the past 5 years  
Note: developmental math expires in 2 years.
7. **Biology**- You must have completed BIO 121 with a grade of "C" or better within 5 years or less from the time of admission; **Psychology**- You must have completed PSY 101 with a grade of "C" or better; **English** – You must have completed ENG 101 with a grade of "C" or better.
  - *Is English your 2<sup>nd</sup> language?* If so, you must take the TOEFL or IELTS & achieve a minimum or greater scores of 20-22-26-20 & 6.5-6.5-8-5.5 respectively (**must be completed prior to applying**).
8. **Meet with Counseling and Advising**: U267, (217) 351-2219, to review assessment scores and to create a plan of study, [counselingservices@parkland.edu](mailto:counselingservices@parkland.edu)
9. **Take the Kaplan Nursing Assessment Test**. Call 217/351-2432 or stop by the Parkland Assessment Center for more information or to make an appointment. You may take the test twice.
10. Make sure your address is correct for college records. Moved recently? Complete a Change of Address form and return to Admissions in room U-214.
11. Submit this form and \$10 application fee
  - Email the completed form to [admissions@parkland.edu](mailto:admissions@parkland.edu). Admissions will contact you regarding payment.
