Parkland -ICTM Regional Math Contest

Information for New Coaches

- Although this is intended as a high school competition, Parkland College allows seventh- and eighth-graders. However, these students will participate only for Parkland awards and will not be recognized by ICTM or be allowed to advance to the State finals, regardless of scores.
- 2. The basic means of communication is online. It is extremely important that you read and respond to our emails.
- 3. All registration is online, and there are three basic registration steps:
 - a. Now: register your school with ICTM at their website.
 - b. January: enter a Combined Parkland-ICTM Roster at Parkland's website.
 - and c. February: enter an ICTM-Only Roster at ICTM's website.

Schools notifying us in the fall that they plan to attend the regional at Parkland will be put on a mailing list and receive further instructions about roster entry later on.

- 4. Schools registering for the first time with ICTM will automatically receive from ICTM a contest manual and a set of questions from last year.
- 5. Information about the orals topic can be found at ICTM's website, www.ictm.org. It is the coach's responsibility to obtain the orals reference materials; the regional sites do not provide them.
- 6. Special Needs

All requests pertaining to special needs, including requests to use foreign language dictionaries, must be received in writing by the State Math Contest Chair by February 1 for the regional competition, and by April 1 for the State Competition.
