Yesterday, President Ramage announced that our campus will be making the shift to a primarily online format starting March 23 and continuing through April 3. Labs and studio classes will still be held on campus. The campus will remain open. <u>Please watch for communication from your instructors for specific course information</u>. Please remember that the campus is closed entirely on Friday, March 20<sup>th</sup> and no facilities, offices or services will be open that day. # **Course Delivery and Technology**
