

Here's an opportunity for students to explore a technology driven career! We're hosting FREE hands-on workshops for Land Surveying/Construction Management and Automotive! Interested students choose one of the exciting workshop events on April 21st from 9 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.! Lunch will be provided.

SURV-CON - At Surv-Con, students will experience common activities performed by Land Surveyors and construction personnel. Students will build walls for a small shed using multiple tools and modern equipment. They will also work with the surveying instruments to map an area and then use GPS to accurately mark the location of the shed to be placed on the ground. Register at parkland.edu/survcon

AUTO - At Auto, students rotate between 4 stations and experience the chassis dyno in action. Students will perform engine diagnostics and learn scan tool usage, along with general hand tool usage and identification.
